

JMSW Program

Requirements for Graduate School Social Work Licensure

1. Students eligible to be considered for admission to this program must be accepted into the JMSW Program, have successfully completed all of their first semester courses if full-time students or first three semesters of courses if they are part-time students (15 graduate hours) and have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
2. At the completion of the first semester of coursework in the full-time JMSW Program or at the completion of the first three semesters of coursework in the part-time JMSW Program, interested students must complete an *Application for Graduate Licensure in School Social Work* and return it to the Coordinator of the School Social Work Licensure Program.
3. This application form (found on following page) must be returned to the Coordinator of School Social Work Licensure by January 20th of the spring semester for 1st year full-time students and 2nd year part-time students. A review of the student's application will be completed to determine either an admission or denial of admission to the Graduate Licensure Program in School Social Work. Students who have met the minimum eligibility criteria to be considered for admission to this program are not guaranteed this recommendation. A limited number of placements in school settings are available each year for field placements. If the number of interested applicants exceeds available placements, a priority order for acceptance into this program will be based on students' overall GPA.
4. Students recommended for admission to this program will have their paperwork processed either through the NC A & T State University Teacher Education Program or the UNCG Teacher Education Program. Students' admission materials for this program are processed through the campus where they were initially admitted to the JMSW Program.
5. Students must complete their academic year long field instruction in a school setting (SWK 606 and SWK 616).
6. Students must successfully complete SWK 582, School Social Work, with a minimum grade of B.
7. Students' area of practice will be Social Work with Families & Youth at Risk. They must successfully complete SWK 601/SOWK 710, Social Work with Families & Youth at Risk I, and SWK 611/SOWK 711, Social Work with Families & Youth at Risk II.
8. Approximately one month before completion of above requirements, students apply for Licensure "M" through either the UNCG or NC A&T State University School of Education by completing the form titled *Request for North Carolina Licensure for Professional Personnel (Graduate and Licensure Only Applicants)*.
